Dear players,

Congratulations with you selection for the European Senior Championships 2024 (ESC24) in Heusden-Zolder.

Since we have a lot of new players, we would like to give you some more information regarding the clothing regulations for this ESC24

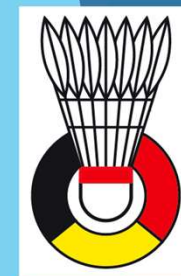
For this ESC24 the [European Senior Champion regulations - appendix IX](#) (articles 11 and 12) and the [BWF General Competition Regulation](#) (Section 5.1 articles 20 to 24) will apply.



Summary of specific clothing rules ESC24

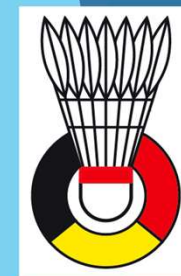
- Name on the back of the shirt
 - Optional
 - If present: must be between 6cm and 10cm
 - If present: must be the last name as in the BWF database
 - If present: single colour and contrasting with the shirt
(for instance, black letters on white shirt and not yellow letters on a white shirt)

- Country name on the back of the shirt
 - Optional
 - If present: must be 5cm
 - If present: single colour and contrasting with the shirt
 - If present: must be the country you represent



Colour of players clothing's

- In singles matches
 - **it is recommended** that, from the quarter finals onwards, the opposing players in each match wear **different colours** from each other
- In doubles matches
 - **it is recommended** for doubles partners to wear the same colour.
 - **For the finals** it is **obligated** that doubles partners wear **the same colour**.
- Changing shirt during the interval: it has to be a shirt with the same design and colour



Colour of players clothing's

- In doubles matches
 - **it is recommended** that, from the quarter finals onwards, the **opposing pairs** in each match wear **different colours** from each other.



Players shoes

- Shoes that leave markings on a badminton court...
 - are not allowed!
 - **not willing or able to change** means you are **not allowed to play** your match.
 - this will be decided by the Referee immediately.
 - the player will be disqualified for this event.
 - the player can still play other events he/she entered.



Compression socks

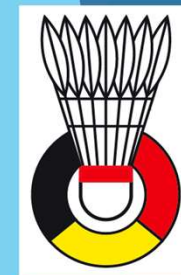
- Compression socks are not considered when applying the regulations on advertising



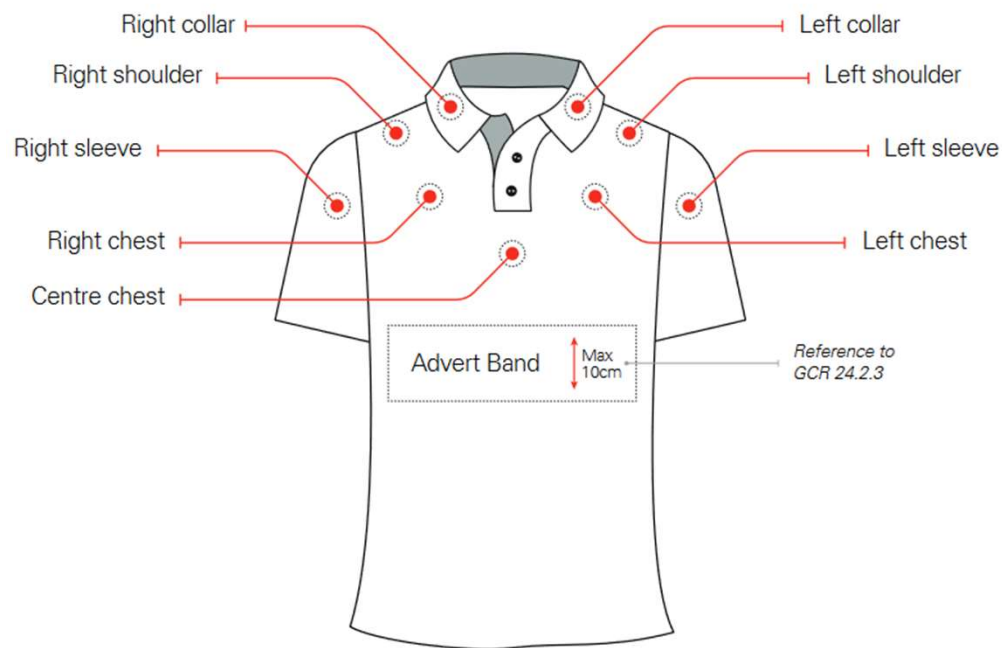
Advertising on players' clothing



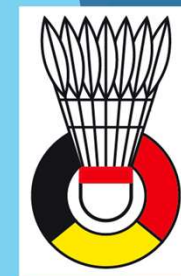

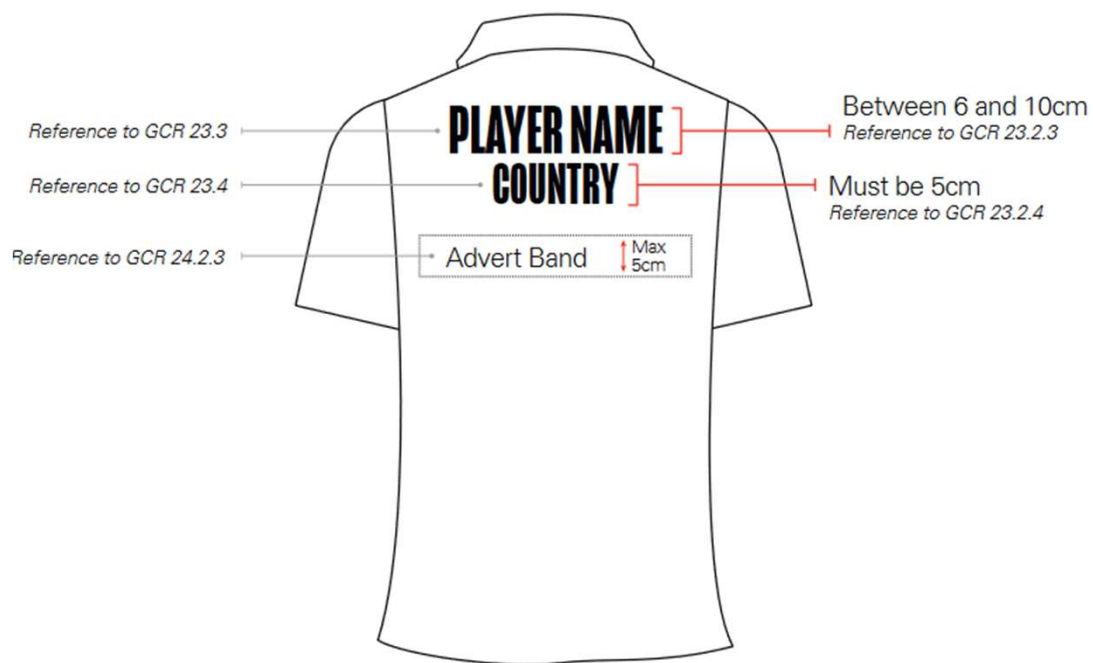
Advertising on players' shirt (front)



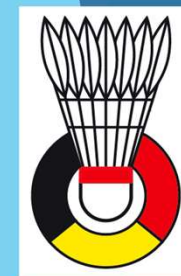
- Maximum five (5) advertisements out of the nine (9) locations. Maximum one (1) per location. No larger than 20 square cm. *Reference to General Competition Regulations (GCR) 24.2.1.*



Advertising on players' shirt (back)



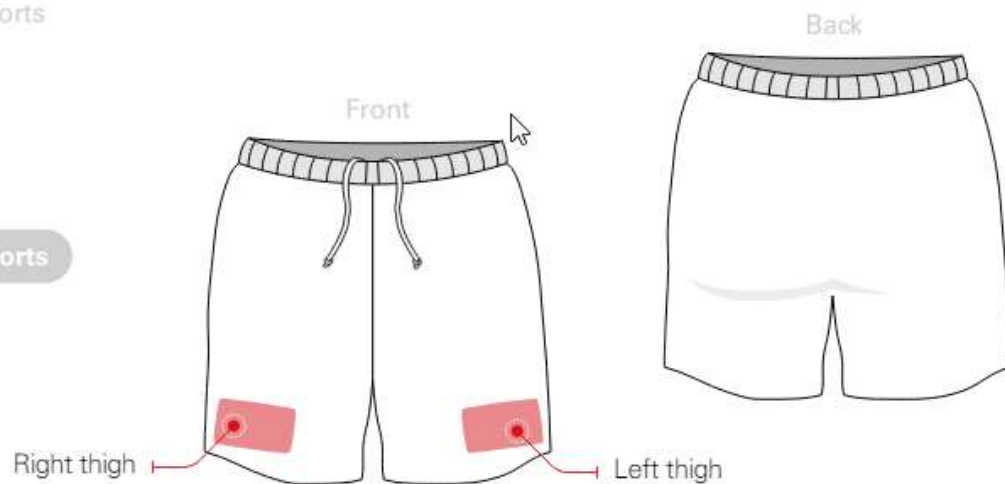
Maximum one (1) advertisement on the back in a band no higher (wider) than five (5) cm. *Reference to GCR 24.2.1.*

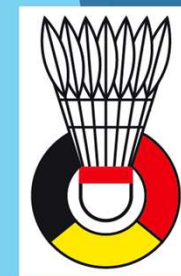

 Advertising area

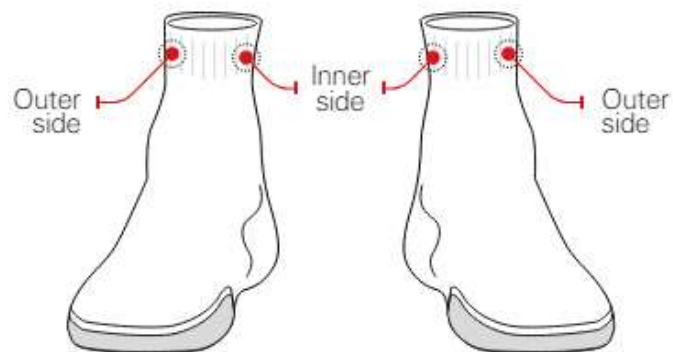
Each advertisement can be anywhere within the shaded zone (advertising area).

-  Maximum one (1) advertisement no larger than 20 square cm (*Reference to GCR 24.3.3*) unless approved MA advertising. Approved MA advertising no larger than 50 square cm (*Reference to GCR 24.4*).

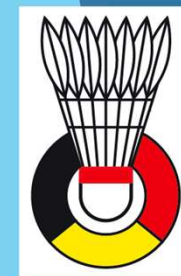


Advertising on players' socks

Socks

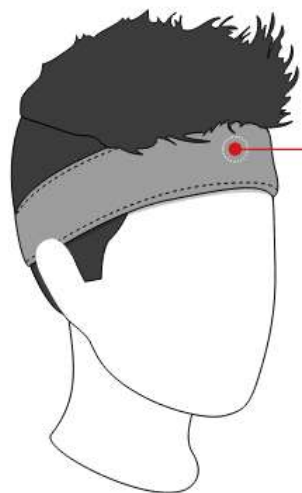


- Maximum two (2) advertisements per sock. No larger than 20 square cm.
Reference to GCR 24.3.1.



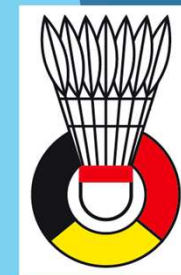
Advertising on other clothing

Maximum one (1) advertisement no larger than 20 square cm (*Reference to GCR 24.3.3*). Advertisement can be place anywhere.

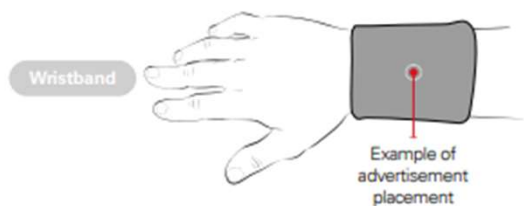


Advertising on other clothing (cont)

Clothing worn under player shirts, shorts, skirts or dresses, shall be known as ‘underclothing’ and not categorised as ‘articles of clothing’, and if visible must not display advertising.

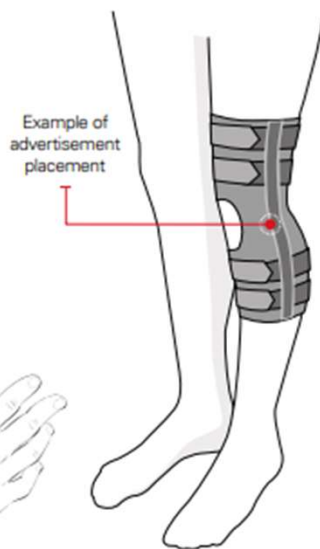


Advertising on medical supports

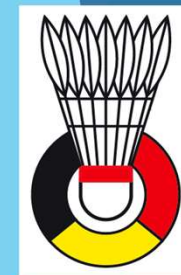
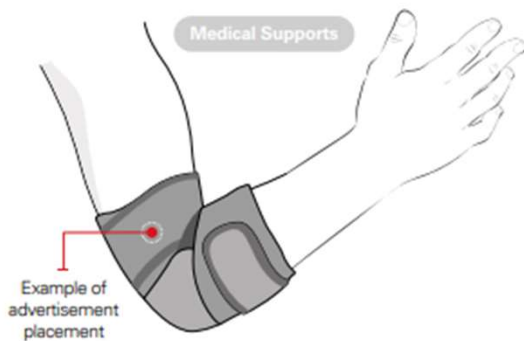


● Maximum one (1) advertisement no larger than 20 square cm (*Reference to GCR 24.3.3*). Advertisement can be place anywhere.

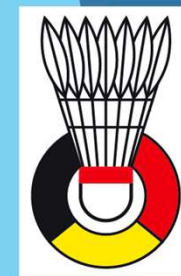

Clothing during prize giving ceremony

➤ During the presentation ceremony

- players may wear tracksuits or uniform.
- regulations for shirts governs tracksuit jackets.
- regulations for shorts governs tracksuit pants.
- regulations for it must also **comply with clothing advertising regulations.**
- **must not carry headgear, rackets, racket bags and national flags**
